PEAREN — Mr. J. H. (Bert) Pearen, age 89 years, of Dawson Court, died there on Wednesday, November 21, 1973. Born in Clinton, Ontario, son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Herbert Pearen, he moved to Brandon, Manitoba in 1904 and was married there to the former Miss. Blanche Todd in 1914. He later moved to Winnipeg where he was employed with the Hudson Bay Company, as a Department Manager, for many years until his retirement. While in Winnipeg, he was very active in the community and his church. Following his retirement, he was engaged as a Funeral Director at Roland, Manitoba. In 1947 he moved to Port Arthur [Ontario] and was employed in various clothing stores and also at the Waverly Hotel for a number of years. A member of Trinity United Church, he served on the board for many years. Also a member of the Port Arthur Lodge No. 499 A. F. and A. M., he had been a Mason for over 50 years. During his younger years, he was very interested in curling, bowling and music. Survived by his wife Blanche; four sons Todd E. of Winnipeg; Glen L. of Sioux Lookout; Jack H. of Garden Grove, California; H. Bayne of 424 Dufferin Street; 13 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren; nieces, nephews, and other relatives. Predeceased by two brothers, Milton and Ernest.
